Paragraph and negation: (4pts)

- Ali travels to London every summer. ≠ Ali doesn't travel to London every summer.
- I go to the club twice a week. ≠ I don't go to the club twice a week.
- We went to London by plane. ≠ We didn't go to London by plane.
- She always gets up late. ≠ She never gets up late.

Unit2

The opposite of adjectives: (3 pts)

Far ≠ near, fast ≠ slow , heavy ≠ light, high ≠ low, long ≠ short, thick ≠ thin.

Nouns of verbs and adjectives: (4 pts)

High → height, long → length.

Hard → hardness, heavy → heaviness, near → nearness.

To develop → development, to measure → measurement, to move → movement.

Numbers in letters: (3 pts)

πr^2 = pi r squared. \sqrt{X} = the square root of x.

x^3 = x cubed. $\sqrt[3]{X}$ = the cube root of X.

X^5 = x to the power five. x^{-5} = x to the power minus five
