Dramatis Personae: refers to the characters represented in a dramatic work. This phrase is the conventional heading for a list of characters published in the text of a play.

Stage Directions: a description (as of a character or setting) or direction provided in the text of a play, usually indicated with italics and/or parentheses. May indicate where the scene takes place, what a character is supposed to do, or how a character should deliver certain lines.

Soliloquy: a dramatic speech uttered by one character speaking aloud while alone on the stage.

Lyric poetry: A short poem expressing the personal mood, feeling, or meditation of a single speaker.

Epiphany: the term used in Christian theology for a manifestation of God's presence in the world. It refers to a sudden spiritual manifestation.
